Northeastern Connecticut Transit District provides public transportation to northeastern Connecticut and is open to ALL members of the public.

The District provides deviated fixed route service where persons may pick up the bus at the designated stops or you may flag the bus down at a viable/safe location for pick-up along its route. Additionally, the bus may be deviated up to 3/4 of a mile from the published route by contacting the District by 1:00 p.m. the day prior to the pick up date, or by Friday for weekend requests. Due to scheduling constraints -- off route service may be limited.

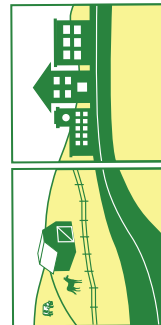

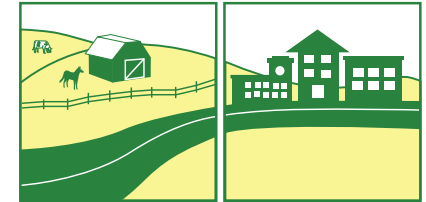
