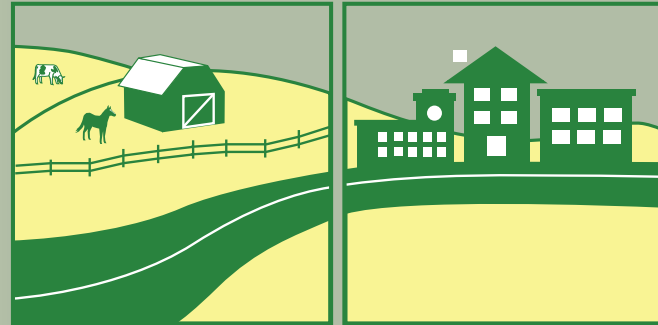

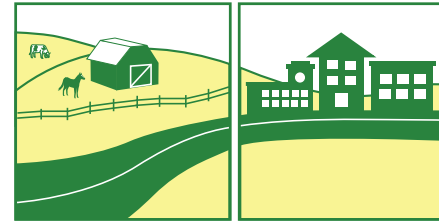

The **Northeastern Connecticut Transit District**, which operates Monday - Saturday, is the public transportation provider for northeastern Connecticut. NECTD offers two types of services: A deviated-fixed route service in the towns of **Brooklyn, Killingly, Putnam and Thompson** and elderly-disabled door-to-door services for persons living in **Brooklyn, Canterbury, Killingly, Eastford, Plainfield, Pomfret, Putnam, Woodstock, and Union**.

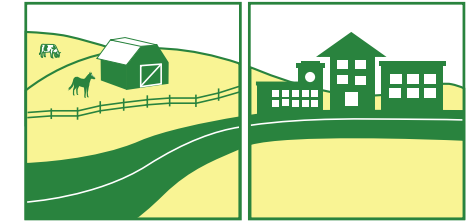
The deviated-fixed route service operates a northern and southern loop with shuttle connections between the loops. Persons may pick up the bus at the designated stops or you may flag the bus down at a viable/safe location for pick-up along its route. The District's Loop Service provides continuous service in the East Brooklyn, Danielson, Rogers, Dayville area (Southern Loop and the Putnam Special Services District and North Grosvenordale area (Northern Loop). The bus may be deviated from the published route by contacting the District by 1:00 p.m. the day prior to the pick up date. Due to scheduling constraints -- off route service may be limited.

The District also offers door-to-door service for qualified elderly and disabled persons. Persons are required to fill out a simple application to qualify and this application is available on our website (nectd.org), by calling us (860-774-3902) or stopping by our office at 125 Putnam Pike in Dayville.

When requested – the District will provide alternative format schedules and other transit related information. If you or someone you know that has limited English proficiency – we will help. Each of our buses is fully ADA certified and have wheel chair lifts. Additionally, our buses are equipped with bicycle racks.

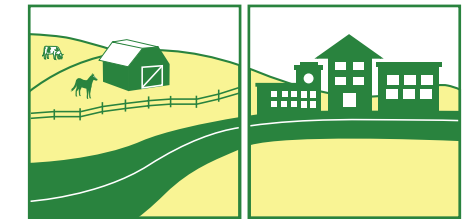
